How does it work?

- **Work experience** - each student will have their own bespoke work placement timetable which sits alongside their teaching and learning; placements will be developed around a young person's passion and future career goals. Most of the experience on this course will take place at Airborn Academy and students are set a target of 1,000 voluntary hours over two academic years.
- **Guest speaker series** - at strategic points in the academic year the course welcomes professionals from the world of sport to deliver workshops and Q&A sessions; these experts range from sports media personalities to sports scientists and everything in between,

Frequently Asked Questions

If I choose the LLS course with Airborn Academy, can I still do A-Levels?

It is possible to do A-Levels alongside the LLS course. The choices available to you will be dictated by timetables and the grades you achieve/achieved at GCSE.

Do you have to pay to study on the LLS course?

Sixth form courses are government funded in the same way A-Levels or other college courses would be, meaning you don't have to pay to study with LLS.

What will I need to wear?

You will receive a kit, tracksuit & rain jacket on your first day of the course. You will be given access to an online shop if you would like to buy any extra pieces of kit.

What GCSE's will I need to get to join LLS?

Sports Industry Course - BTEC Level 3 Extended Diploma

Entry Requirements = a minimum of 5 GCSE's from Grades 4 to 9, ideally to include an English and PE or a Pass at BTEC sport.

How do I register my interest in this course?

You will need to complete a registration form which is available on our website or can be collected from reception at Airborn Academy. Once completed you will be invited to attend a taster session and interview with members of LLS education team.
